General: Based on Observation, the child care center director failed assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Upon surveyor's arrival at the child care center on 1/27/17 at 8:00 am, interview with staff members revealed there was not a person designated as the staff in charge present at the child care center.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:

- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented staff files revealed a staff member with the hire date 11/01/16 did not have a high school diploma, GED or Commonwealth Child Care Credential on file at the time of the survey. Interview with the director revealed she was unable to locate the document at the time of the survey.

340 - Training Not In Compliance

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
  - (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented staff files revealed staff members with the hire dates; 9/1/05, 6/8/15 and an employee transferred on 11/1/16 did not complete Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. Review of the ECE TRIS report verified the training hours were not completed. Interview with the director revealed an acknowledgement of the deficient practice

#### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, and interview, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the kindergarten bathroom revealed light bulbs that were not shielded or shatter proof. Interview with the director revealed an acknowledgment of the deficiency.

585 - Sink Not In Compliance

## 922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

#### Findings

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the kindergarten room and kindergarten/first grade room revealed the water temperature registered eighty-five (85) degrees Fahrenheit in the sinks at the time of the survey.

Observation of the playground revealed on the right side close to a picnic table a wire on the bottom of the fence was not secured causing a tripping hazard for children.

## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain an outdoor play are in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the playground area with the climbing apparatus revealed the bottom of the fence located by the second entrance is not secured at the bottom and is in disrepair.
