The surveyor found that the childcare center's Discipline Policy was not followed which states "Discipline will not be associated in any way with rest time, using the toilet or toilet training, or meals and snacks".</p>

Child Care Services.</p> <p>(8) A child shall not be required to stand or sit for a prolonged period of time:</p> <p>(a) During an activity;</p> <p>(b) While waiting for an activity to start; or</p> <p>(c) As punishment.</p> <p>Findings:</p> <p>General: Based on interview, multiple staff confirm that a two-year-old child is placed in a high chair for time out purposes. The staff estimate that the child sits in the high chair from five to fifteen (5-15) minutes. The child is required to sit in the high chair for up to fifteen (15) minutes with no activities.</p>	

922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.

(10) A child shall not be subjected to:

- (a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);**
- (b) Loud, profane, threatening, frightening, or abusive language; or**
- (c) Discipline that is associated with:**
 - 1. Rest;**
 - 2. Toileting; or**
 - 3. Food.**

Findings:

General: Based on interview, multiple staff confirm that a two-year-old child is placed in a high chair for time out purposes. The staff estimate that the child sits in the high chair from five to fifteen (5-15) minutes. Therefore, placing a child in a high chair for time out purposes associates discipline with food.
