- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor was presented with a child's (DOE: 9/3/2020) file that was missing the preferred hospital listed with phone number. Staff stated that she did not notice the missing information and that she would pay closer attention.
