Findings: General: Based on observation, upon entry to room #10 a caregiver was found sleep in a chair during naptime. Seven (7) children were in the caregiver's care at the time. **Emergency Regulation** Not In Compliance 1250 - Emergency Regulation Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:400E. Emergency Regulation. Findings: General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the center failed to assure: 1.) A caregiver's face mask did not cover her nose in room #13. A caregiver's face mask was on her chin in room #14 and room #16.

2.) School-age children may wear a face mask if temperament and developmentally abilities permits in accordance with 922 KAR 2:400E Section 7(4). A six-year-old child did not wear a mask in the school age room.
