General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) There were two wooden climbers located on the large playground that contained equipment used to climb and slide. The mulch beneath both pieces of equipment was sparse and had areas where the dirt beneath was visible.
- 2) The toddler playground contained two slides that had been placed on dirt with a scattering of mulch around and underneath the equipment. The dirt was visible through the scattering of mulch.
