- (a) Kept at a temperature of zero degrees Fahrenheit or below; and
- (b) Thawed:
- 1. At refrigerator temperatures;
- 2. Under cool, potable running water;
- 3. As part of the cooking process; or

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the interior temperature of the freezer containing the children's food was twenty (20) degrees Fahrenheit.

- (a) Breast milk or iron-fortified formula for a child age birth to twelve (12) months;

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the children whose ages ranged from three to five (3-5) years were served pasteurized 2% milk with their lunch.

- 1. Two (2) of the children's (DOE: 08/16/16) files contained immunization certificates without expiration dates; therefore, the children's immunization status could not be determined.
- 2. A child's (DOE: 08/09/16) file contained an immunization certificate that was no longer current as on 12/16/15.
