General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a staff's (DOH: 7/27/2015) personnel file contained a written performance evaluation dated for 3/3/2020. Staffin-charge stated that the employee did not have an evaluation completed in 2021 **Employee Records**

435 - Training Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements. (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the staff's (DOH: 7/24/2016) file did not contain verification that the staff had completed fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. Upon reviewing ECE-TRIS for the timeframe of 7/1/20 thru 6/30/21, the surveyor discovered that the staff had completed eleven (11) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.

(3) A sink shall be:

(a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;

(b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;

(c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;

(d) Equipped with liquid soap;

(e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;

(f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and

(g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the hot water temperature of three (3) sinks had a temperature reading of seventy (70) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the water temperature of the sinks was not within the required temperature reading of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum reading of one hundred twenty (120) degrees Fahrenheit. One sink was located in the Two to Four Classroom. The second sink was located in the Four to Five Classroom and the third sink was located between two (2) classrooms.

Staff-in-charge stated she would have the hot water heater checked as the tankless water heater may need to be replaced.
