General: Based on observation and interview, three (3) caregivers supervised thirteen (13) children from 9:28 a.m. until 12:45 p.m. The age of the youngest child was one-year-old, therefore, the maximum group size was not maintained.

General: Based on observation, a caregiver's purse was stored on the corner of a desk and a caregiver's coat hung on the back of the chair in preschool room #1. A large bottle of hand sanitizer was labeled "Keep out of reach of children," and was stored on a counter in the preschool room #1. A bottle of hand sanitizer was labeled "Keep out of reach of children," and was stored on a shelf in preschool room #2. All of these items were accessible to children.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:410E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the center failed to assure:

- 1). Machine washable toys shall not be used, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:410E Section 6(3). Surveyor observed clothing for baby dolls in the preschool room.
- 2). Staff shall wear gloves when preparing meals and serving bottles. Gloves shall be changed between bottle feedings, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:410E Section 8(6). A caregiver did not wear gloves when she fed an infant child a bottle in the infants' room.
- 3). All child care staff, directors, owners, and operators shall complete a new, mandatory training on cleaning, sanitizing, health procedures, and mandatory reporting prior to the date of reopening, in accordance with 922KAR2:410E Section 9 (1). A caregiver hired 04/08/17, did not have documentation of completing the mandatory training.
