General: Based on review of documentation, one (1) staff hired on 10/04/16 had a TB skin test on file that was no longer current. The TB skin test was dated 10/04/16.

- (3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, there was no one present with current CPR and first aid from 2:30 PM until 6:00 PM on 10/23/18. The facility hours are from 6:00 AM until 6:00 PM. Only one (1) staff had current CPR and first aid. The staff in charge indicated that this staff works from 6:00 AM until 2:30 PM on 10/23/18.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, four (4) staff members did not complete fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within their completed year of employment. A staff hired on 9/19/16 completed eight (8) hours of training. A staff hired on 9/20/16 did not have any training hours. A staff hired on 10/04/16 completed ten (10) hours of training. A staff hired on 10/10/16 completed ten (10) hours of training. The ECE-TRIS system and the staff files were reviewed.

General: Based on observation, the One to Two (1-2) year-old room did not contain a variety of creative activities that included multi-cultural items. The only multi-cultural items observed in the classroom were a poster and a book.

General: Based on review of documentation, one (1) child's file contained an immunization certificate that was no longer current. The immunization certificate stated it was no longer current fourteen (14) days after 8/14/18. The child was enrolled on 1/09/18.

(1) A licensed child-care center shall have a written evacuation plan in the event of a fire, natural disaster, or other threatening situation that may pose a health or safety hazard for a child in care in accordance with KRS 199.895 and 42 U.S.C. 9858c(c)(2)(U).

General: Based on review of documentation, the facility did not have written evidence that the emergency preparedness plan was updated and submitted to the local emergency management officials annually.
