General: Based on review of documentation, the center's child abuse policy was not in compliance with KRS 620.030, which required anyone who suspects child abuse or neglect to report these allegations to the cabinet or law enforcement. Instead, the center's policy stated if staff had reason to believe that a child has been abused or neglected, they are to report to the director immediately, and the director will report it to the proper authorities.

General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) staff, hired on 07/25/17, each had documentation of completing nine (9) hours of cabinet approved training during a subsequent vear of employment.

General: Based on observation, a container of Clorox bleach wipes was stored on a shelf, that was three (3) feet from the floor, in an unlocked black, wooden cabinet in the threeyear-olds' room. In addition, a container of Clorox bleach wipes was stored on a shelf, two (2) feet from the floor, in a second unlocked black, wooden cabinet in the three-year-olds'
