General: Based on Review of Documentation, four (4) staff did not have current TB documentation in their file. Their hire dates were 9/22/99, 3/21/16, 1/11/17 and 1/11/17.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, at the time of the survey, there was no one working with a current First Aid certification. There was only one person employed who had first aid; the hire date was 1/11/17.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, one staff person did not complete the required yearly training; their hire date was 3/21/16. Two (2) staff did not complete the required PAHT within five (5) years; their hire dates were 9/22/99 and 3/10/10. These hours were verified in the employee files as well as on ECE-TRIS.

General: Based on Observation, a child was asleep in a crib with a blanket. The teacher stated the child would be one (1) year old in a couple of weeks.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, in the three (3) to five (5) year old classroom, there was a bottle of Disinfectant Spray located on a shelf with the diapers. The bottle states "Keep out of Reach of children" on the front. Under the diaper changing area in this same room was an unlocked cabinet that contained adult scissors and a bottle of Hand Sanitizer with a sign on the bottle, "Keep out of Reach of Children."

- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, in the three (3) to five (5) year old room, there was a sink located next to the diaper changing area. The warm water only reached 63 degrees. The sink in the bathroom area located in this same room only reached 63 degrees as well.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, one (1) child did not have a contact number for their physician; the child's enrollment date was 6/17/13. There was one (1) child who did not have a hospital listed; the enrollment date was 9/16/16. One (1) child did not have an authorized pick up list; the enrollment date was 8/24/15. One (1) child did not have a signed emergency care document; the enrollment date was 10/30/12.
