<b>Findings:</b> General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a two-year-old child sustained two (2) cuts, approximately two (2) inches long on his left shoulder at approximately 12:35 pm on 2/22/22 in the one and two-year-olds' room. The child was shirtless while he rested on a mat located under a window. High winds blew out the window and pieces of glass cut the child on the shoulder and lodged underneath skin on the child's chest. The child was transported by helicopter to a hospital where glass was removed from his chest and he received treatment for cuts on the shoulder.
