General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the hand-washing sink located in the Jungle Room contained dark stains and grime inside the sink bowl; therefore, the sink was not clean.

645 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the hand-washing sink located in the Preschool Room was not equipped with single use disposable hand drying materials.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) The toilet located in the Yellow Room's restroom contained feces; therefore, the toilet was not in a clean condition.
- (2.) A toilet located in the Kindergarten Room's restroom had a broken toilet seat; therefore, the toilet was not in good repair.
