# 1250 - Emergency Regulation

## 922 KAR 2:400E. Emergency Regulation.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:400E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, it was found that the classroom that is going to be used for school aged children did not have proper walls in place to meet the emergency regulations. Two shelving units were being used and then a baby gate was hooked between the shelves and the wall of the room.
