- (1) A person who is a child care staff member prior to January 1, 2018, shall submit to and complete background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation no later than September 30, 2018.
- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on review of the Kentucky National Background Check Service, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff (DOH: 06/15/21) had a fingerprint submit date of 06/28/21 and an eligibility date of 06/28/21; therefore, the staff person was hired prior to clearance for employment. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she was not aware that staff persons had to submit to fingerprints prior to employment. Staff-in-charge stated that the staff person did not work alone with children. The staff's file did not contain a Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check or Criminal Records Background Check.
- 2. A staff (DOH:10/27/21) had a fingerprint submit date of 11/01/21 and an eligibility date of 11/01/21; therefore, the staff person was hired prior to clearance for employment. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she was not aware that staff persons had to submit to fingerprints prior to employment. Staff-in-charge stated that the staff person did not work alone with children. The staff's file did not contain a Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check or Criminal Records Background Check.
- 3. A staff (DOH: 02/22/21) had a fingerprint submit date of 02/02/22 and an eligibility date of 02/09/22; therefore, the staff person did not have a completed background check prior to 10/01/21. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she was not aware that the staff person had to have a completed background check through KARES by 10/01/21. Staff-incharge stated that the staff person did not work alone with children. The staff's file contained a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check dated 03/09/21 and a completed Criminal Records Background Check dated 02/24/21.
- 4. A staff (DOH: 08/21/20) had a fingerprint submit date of 02/14/22 and an eligibility date of 02/14/22; therefore, the staff person did not have a completed background check prior to 10/01/21. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she was not aware that the staff person had to have a completed background check through KARES by 10/01/21. Staff-incharge stated that the staff person did not work alone with children. The staff's file contained a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check dated 09/08/20 and a completed Criminal Records Background Check dated 08/28/20.
- 5. A staff (DOH: 06/15/20) had a fingerprint submit date of 11/01/21 and an eligibility date of 11/01/21; therefore, the staff person did not have a completed background check prior to 10/01/21. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she was not aware that the staff person had to have a completed background check through KARES by 10/01/21. Staff-incharge stated that the staff person did not work alone with children. The staff's file contained a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check dated 07/01/20 and a completed Criminal Records Background Check dated 06/23/20.

General: Based on observation and review of the Kentucky National Background Check Service, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. There was an unsecured brown cord coming down behind a crib in the Infant Classroom. Staff-in-charge stated that she would move the cord to make it inaccessible to the
- 2. A telephone cord was hanging down from a wall mounted telephone in the Three Year Old Classroom. Staff-in-charge stated that she would move the cord to make it inaccessible to the children.

- 2. A staff (DOH: 01/23/20) obtained six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training on 09/14/20; therefore, the training was not completed within the first three (3) months of

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A brown residue was located on the countertop behind the faucet in the One Year Old Classroom; therefore, the countertop was not kept clean.
- 2. A metal soap dish placed on the wall beside the sink in the restroom in the Two Year Old Classroom contained a brown substance that was built up on the bottom of the soap dish; therefore, the soap dish was not kept clean. The Two Year Old Classroom was located beside the Three Year Old Classroom.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a small circular hole toward the bottom of the wall located beside the exit door in the One Year Old Classroom; therefore, the wall was not in good repair.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. There was debris on the diaper changing table underneath the diaper changing pad in the One Year Old Classroom; therefore, the diaper changing surface was not kept clean.
- 2. There was debris on the diaper changing table underneath the diaper changing pad and two (2) small rips/tears in the diaper changing pad in the Two Year Old Classroom located beside the Office; therefore, the diaper changing surface was not kept clean or free of holes, rips, tears, or other damage.
- 3. There was debris on the diaper changing table underneath the diaper changing pad in the Two Year Old Classroom located beside the Three Year Old Classroom; therefore, the diaper changing surface was not kept clean.
- 4. There was debris on the diaper changing table underneath the diaper changing pad in the Tiny Tots Classroom; therefore, the diaper changing surface was not kept clean. The diaper changing table was located in front of the sink area.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. What appeared to be two (2) large mushrooms were located on the ground beside a tree on the playground that was located along the side of the Tiny Tots and One Year Old Classrooms. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that they have tried to cut the mushrooms down; however, they grow back. Staff-in-charge stated that they have moved the children to the other playground located on the opposite side of the building and have scheduled times for the children to go out to the playground.
- 2. The top layer of the material on the sides of the bridge on the play structure located on the playground behind the child-care center building was peeling and contained a sharp edge.
- 3. Approximately three (3) areas on the bottom steps of the play structure located on the playground behind the child-care center building were cracked/peeling and exposed what appeared to be metal beneath which contained rust.
- 4. The top layer of the material on a small section of the bridge on the play structure located on the playground behind the child-care center building contained an area that was peeling.

During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she had bought the materials to repair the play structure.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a small brown two (2) drawer shelf that was peeling on the top front part of the shelf located beside a crib in the Infant Classroom; therefore, the shelf was not kept free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.
