<b>Findings:</b> General: Based on Review of Documentation and interviews, the center's discipline policy stated, "TCA does not: inflict corporal punishment on any child; use any strategy that hurts, shames or belittles a child; use any strategy that threatens, intimidates or forces a child.... embarrasses any child in front of others." Staff failed to implement the discipline policy when a child stood in a chair and a staff member tapped/hit the child on the butt at approximately 8:40 am on 10/03/18 in the dining room. The child cried as a result of being hit.

<b>Findings:</b> General: Based on interviews, the director failed to provide for the comfort of a child when a staff member tapped/hit the child on the butt at approximately 8:40 am on 10/03/18 while in the dining room. The child cried as a result of being hit.
