General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulations. Observation of the Infant Room revealed the wall was splintered and rough due to the door leading to the classroom bathroom rubbing against the walls surface. Continued observation in the indoor play area revealed several areas of paint chipping and peeling around the window.

Continued observation revealed portions of the exterior of the shed that were splintered, and a corner of the shed in which two (2) wooden planks had pulled apart, exposing large nails.
