## Findings

General: Based on observation during a tour of the childcare center, the surveyor found the following in the Infant Room:

- 1. An infant child was wearing a bib while sleeping in a crib.
- 2. An infant child sleeping in swing.

During a tour of the kitchen and dining area, the surveyor observed that two (2) of the children's coats were laying on a table. The coats were touching; thus, there was potential for cross-contamination. The surveyor observed two (2) blankets and one (1) jacket located on the floor.

- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor was presented with files for two (2) staff members and found the following:

- 1. One (1) staff (DOH: 11/07/18) file did not contain a copy of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional that the individual was free of active tuberculosis.
- 2. One (1) staff (DOH: 12/06/18) file contained a negative tuberculin verification dated 03/15/17, which was no longer current.

During interview, staff confirmed that the current documentation was missing.

General: Based on observation during a tour of the childcare center, the surveyor found that a glue gun had been placed on a shelf of a bulletin board located in the classroom. The glue gun was accessible to the children.

- 3. There were two (2) stained ceiling tiles in the boy's restroom located on the left near the office.

- (4) A cold-storage facility used for storage of perishable food in a nonfrozen state shall:
- (a) Have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device;
- (b) Be in a safe environment for preservation; and
- (c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

## Findings:

Based on observation during a tour of a classroom, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The thermometer located in the refrigerator indicated that the temperature was fifty-seven (57) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the refrigerated food was not kept at a temperature of forty (40) degrees.
- 2. The thermometer located in the freezer indicated that the temperature was seventy (70) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the freezer was not kept at a temperature of zero (0) degrees or below.

During interview, staff stated that the refrigerator was not working properly and that it would be removed from the center.

# 1040 - Kitchen Equipment Clean and Sanitary

- (7) The following shall be clean and sanitary:
- (a) Eating and drinking utensils;
- (b) Kitchenware;
- (c) Food contact surfaces of equipment;

- (f) Cooking surfaces of equipment; and
- (g) Nonfood contact surfaces of equipment.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, during a tour of the childcare center kitchen, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The oven was soiled with an unknown, dried-on, substance.
- 2. Two (2) microwaves contained baked on food particles.
- 3. A pink tinted liquid had poured onto the drawers and base of the refrigerator.

Staff stated during interview that the items would be cleaned immediately and that she would discuss with staff the safety of keeping the area clean.
