Findings:

General: Based on observation while performing the initial walk-through to obtain the classroom headcount, the surveyor observed four (4) three-year-old children napping in the Three-Year-Old Classroom unsupervised for four (4) minutes. When staff returned to the classroom, staff stated "Sorry, I had to run to the restroom." Therefore, the child-care center failed to provide adequate supervision, ensuring the children were within scope of vision and range of voice.

General: Based on interview, staff-in-charge stated that she has had a difficult time finding staff to work. Staff-in-charge stated that she acts as a substitute as needed; however, she does not have a second substitute employed; therefore the child-care center failed to have available in case of need two (2) qualified substitute staff persons who meet the staff requirements.

- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
- 3. To contain:
- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the file presented for review for a child (DOE: 4/26/2021) did not contain the name or telephone number for the preferred physician; therefore, the child-care center failed to maintain children's records.
