General: Based on observation, three Little Tike picnic tables were unstable while propped in separate rooms. In the younger two-year-olds' room, the table was propped on its end with legs pointing towards children. A second Little Tikes table was propped on its end in front of a wooden kitchen set with the legs pointing towards children. Lastly, the third Little Tikes table was propped against a shelf and mirror with legs pointing towards children in the two-year-olds' room. Each presented a safety hazard to children. Interviews determined the picnic tables were propped to allow the children additional play space.

- (3) A toddler may participate in an activity with an older child for more than one (1) hour per day if:
- (a) The toddler is in transition to the pre-school age group;
- (b) The toddler is twenty-one (21) months or older;
- (c) Space for the toddler is available in the preschool-age group;
- (d) The staff-to-child ratios and group sizes are maintained based the age of the youngest child;
- (e) The center has a procedure for listing a transitioning toddler on attendance records, including a specific day and time the toddler is with either age group; and
- (f) The child care center has obtained the signature and approval of the toddler's parent on the toddler's transition plan.

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a child (date of birth: 08/17/15) did not have a transition plan on file and was combined with the younger two-vear-old childern for more than one hour on 05/12/17.

General: Based on observation, the caregiver used Pamper baby wipes to clean the changing mat after she changed two (2) children's diapers in the young two-year-olds' room. These wipes were not disinfectant wipes.

- (6) Medication, including refrigerated medication, shall be:
- (a) Stored in a separate and locked place, out of the reach of a child;
- (b) Kept in the original bottle; and

- (7) Medication shall not be given to a child if the expiration date on the bottle has passed.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a jar of Desitin relief cream was in the child's cubby that was not locked and not labeled to indicate for whom the medication was intended in the toddlers' room.

A jar of Destin relief cream set on the top ledge of the changing table which hung on the wall was not locked and labeled in the infant room.

- (c) Pasteurized low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk for children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.

General: Based on observation and interview, six (6), one-year-old children were served 2% milk for lunch.
