The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable: (i) Allergies; (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center; e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child; f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;</div>	
Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, two children did not have a preferred hospital listed in their enrollment information at the facility.

(6) In addition to the posting requirement of KRS 199.898(3), a child-care center shall post the following in a conspicuous place and make available for public inspection: (a) The provider's preliminary or regular license; (b) Each statement of deficiency and civil penalty notice issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year; (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year; (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897; (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including: 1. Current rates for child care; and 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care; (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and (g) Daily planned program.</div>	
Findings: General: Based on observation and review of documentation, a lesson plan was not posted in the Four-Year-Old classroom. The staff member in charge of this classroom stated that she keeps her lesson plans in a planner, however the planner was blank for the current week. Additionally, a lesson plan was not posted within the Three-to-Four-Year-Old classroom (107), the staff member had the curriculum written in a daily planner.
