General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. An unlocked black filing cabinet in Classroom 108 that contained the following: A bottle of Germ-X that stated "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the label, Expo White Board Cleaner that stated "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the label, Alpet Surface Sanitizing Wipes that stated "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the label, Goo Gone Pro Power that stated "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the label and an unopened pack of concrete screws.
- 2. A container of Alpet Surface Sanitizing Wipes placed on the edge of a gray desk in the Cafeteria that read "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the label.
- 3. A bottle of Germ-X placed on a brown desk in the Media Center that read "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the back label.
- 4. Two (2) bottles of Germ-X and a bottle of Quill hand sanitizer placed on a table beside the exit door in Classroom 113 that read "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the labels.

General: Based on review of ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff (DOH: 08/17/15) obtained twelve (12) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 07/01/20 –
- 2. A staff (DOH: 03/20/2012) obtained thirteen (13) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 07/01/20 -06/30/21.
- 3. A staff (DOH: 02/06/180) obtained thirteen (13) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 07/01/20 06/30/21.

During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the staff mentioned have completed the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 07/01/20-06/30/21; however, the trainings may not have been uploaded to ECE-TRIS.
