1 staff for 15 children 30

School-age 7 and older

1 staff for 25 children

(for before and after school) 30

1 staff for 20 children

(full day of care) 30

*Maximum Group Size shall be applicable only to Type I child-care centers.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:**
(l) Provide for the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found the following:

- 1) Staff were displaying inappropriate behavior while on duty in the after school facility. As the surveyor entered the cafeteria, it was noted that staff members were falling backwards, and allowing other staff members to catch them. All children were present at this time, had just entered the after school facility, and were preparing for snack.
- 2) A staff member had used a child's personal iPad to take snapshots of himself while on duty at the after school facility.
