435 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.
(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a caregiver hired 07/11/03, completed fourteen point seventy-five (14.75) hours of training between July 1 and the following June 30 of a subsequent year of employment.

(a) A current immunization certificate for each child in care within thirty (30) days of the child's enrollment, unless an attending physician or the child's parent objects to the immunization of the child pursuant to KRS 214.036;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a child first date of attendance on 07/14/21, had an immunization certificate on file that was current until 05/17/21.

1285 - Earthquake/Tornado/Fire Drills **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.
(1) A child-care center shall maintain:
(h) A written record of quarterly practiced earthquake drills and tornado drills detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;
(i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a monthly fire drill was practiced in July 2021, but the date, time and names of children participants were not documented.

1305 - Fire Drills **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.
(12) A fire drill shall be:
(a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
(b) Documented.
(13) An earthquake drill, shelter-in-place or lockdown drill, and tornado drill shall be:
(a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and
(b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on interview, a monthly fire drill was conducted in July 2021 but was not documented.
