922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

(1) A director shall:

(I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, school-age children ages five-to-twelve years old failed to remain with the same group throughout the day, as required by the emergency regulations. Additionally, staff and children ages six-to twelve years old failed to wear face masks as mandated by the Governor's executive order.

The surveyor approached the entrance of the school age child-care center at approximately 12:35 p.m. and immediately observed through the window, a male staff person who was not wearing a face mask. Several school-age children, who were also observed not wearing face masks, were standing near the door and yelling, "Someone is at the door!"

The male staff person opened the door and the surveyor entered the gym. The surveyor noticed immediately that school age children were running and walking back and forth from different areas, and intermingling with each other. The surveyor found it difficult to get a head count of the children and document the area where they belonged.

In an interview with staff, it was stated that "it is hard to keep masks on and chase the kids all day." The surveyor proceeded to walk through the gym and noted that none of the five staff nor the children had on face masks.
