General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the family child care home provider failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. An immunization certificate presented for review for a child with enrollment date 01/11/2016 was no longer current.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the family child care home provider failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the commercial liability insurance documentation revealed the family child care home did not obtain commercial liability insurance of at least \$50,000 per occurrence. The documentation presented for review revealed there was insurance coverage of \$25,000 on personal belongings. Interview with the provider revealed she did have adequate coverage. The provider asked the surveyor to call the insurance agent to confirm the coverage. On 06/11/2021 the surveyor's supervisor called the Kentucky Farm Bureau insurance agent and did confirm the provider did not have the proper insurance coverage.
