General: Based on interview it was determined that the provider became aware on 9/16/13 that she was the named perpetrator in an open DCBS investigation into child abuse and/or neglect. Observation on 9/23/13 revealed that the provider had not removed herself from direct contact with the children and was the sole child care provider on site at the time of this survey.
