- (5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:
- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, interview, and observation, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. A review of a file for a staff member with a hire date of 06/22/17, failed to reveal completed CRC results and CAN results. Interview with the staff in charge revealed the documents were unavailable at the time of the survey. Observation revealed the staff member was not present at the time of the survey.
