General: Review of staff files for staff members with the hire dates, 06/16/2016 and 09/01/2017, revealed there was not verification that the aforementioned staff members had completed fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. Review of the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) report did not verify that the training hours had been completed.
