(1) A director shall: (I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child; Findings: General: Based on observation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the school cafeteria revealed one (1) outlet located next to the entrance door was missing the protective plate and had several wires exposed. **Employee Records** Not In Compliance 395 - TB Verification Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements. (1) Child-care center staff: (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter: 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results. Findings: General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files on 8/15/18 revealed the statement of negative tuberculin result on file for a staff member hired 9/1/97 was no longer current as it was dated 4/18/16. Interview with staff in charge revealed current documentation was not on file at the time of survey.

# 410 - Training

### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed documentation of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training was not presented for review at the time of survey for one (1) staff member hired 11/17/01. Interview with staff in charge revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.
