922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.
(1) The premises shall be:
(a) Suitable for the purpose intended;
(b) Kept clean and in good repair;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, during a tour of the four (4) year old classroom, the surveyor found an unknown dried pink substance on the carpeting that runs alongside the tile. Staff stated she wasn't sure what it was but would have it cleaned up.

645 - Sink **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.
(3) A sink shall be:
(a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
(b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
(c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
(d) Equipped with liquid soap;
(e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
(f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
(g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found in the restroom used by the children in the four (4) year old classroom, that the hot water tap on the sink would not turn on. When the surveyor turned the knob it just continued to spin and the water would not come on. Staff stated that they would request a work order for the repair.

General: Based on observation of the restroom located in the four (4) year old classroom, the surveyor found that a toilet had not been flushed and had what appeared to be urine in the toilet bowl.
