General: Based on observation, the kitchen door was propped open and there was an unlocked kitchen cabinet that contained a can of WD40, plant food, and several cans of spray paint. All of these items were accessible to the children.

General: Based on observation, the kitchen door was propped open and there was a large kitchen knife found in the sink which was accessible to the children.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) There was a ceiling tile coming down in the bathroom of Classroom 2.
- 2) There was a large hole found in the wall right outside the bathroom in the Indoor Gross Motor room. The staff person in charge stated that a sink used to be in that spot and was taken out of the room leaving the hole.
