Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the liability insurance expired on 03/16/22. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the liability insurance was up-to-date; however, she had not received a copy of the updated insurance yet.

225 - Licensee Responsibility

- 922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General. (1) A licensee shall:
- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a staff's (DOH: 02/09/21) file contained two (2) different copies of a Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check (CAN). The surveyor observed the two (2) CAN checks to contain a signature and completion date; however, the results of the CAN checks were not marked on both documents. One (1) of the CAN checks was dated 03/08/21 and the other CAN check was dated 04/09/21. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the staff person was seventeen (17) years of age and has not worked alone with children. The surveyor did not observe the staff person to be at the child-care center on the day of the visit, 04/05/22. Staff-in-charge stated that she was not aware that the results of the two (2) CAN checks were not marked.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff (DOH: 01/03/16) obtained ten and one-half (10 1/2) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 07/01/20 06/30/21.
- 2. A staff (DOH: 03/02/20) obtained seven and one-half (7 1/2) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 03/02/20 03/02/21.
- 3. A staff (DOH: 02/09/21) obtained seven and one-half (7 1/2) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 02/09/21 02/09/22.
- 4. A staff (DOH: 02/04/21) obtained seven and one-half (7 1/2) hours of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the review period 02/04/21 02/04/22.

Findings

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found approximately three (3) ceiling tiles that contained what appeared to be water stains in Classroom B located near the sink; therefore, the ceiling tiles were not in good repair. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that they have called the city to have the ceiling tiles replaced.

695 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the restroom located in Classroom A; therefore, the toilet was not kept in good repair.
- 2. The toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the restroom located in Classroom B; therefore, the toilet was not kept in good repair.
