(2) Activity areas, equipment, and materials shall be arranged so that the child's activity is adequately supervised by staff.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the infant room is divided into two areas by a half wall approximately four feet tall with an opening in the middle that is approximately four feet wide. On one side, there is a diaper-changing table, a small refrigerator, overhead storage cabinets and highchairs. On the other side, there are toys and cribs. There were five infants ages three- to nine-months-old present and one staff person. Two children were placed in highchairs while the staff person changed an infant's diaper. The other two infants were on the other side of the half wall with no adult present. The two infants had been placed on the floor. Although the staff person could hear the infant's they were not within scope of vision.
