- 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who ensures the child is:
- a. Within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

#### Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. On 7/29/2022 a four-year-old child was left unsupervised in the nap room. The class had gone down the hall to the restroom, had a prayer, and then went to the snack room before the child was discovered missing from the group. A staff member located the child in the nap room. The staff indicated that the child was in the dark, asleep on her cot, alone. The child was then taken to the snack room to join the rest of the class. It was estimated that the child was left unsupervised in the nap room for approximately ten (10) minutes.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. On 8/15/2022 during the initial walk-through, there were twenty-one (21) children on the outdoor playground. There were two (2) staff present on the playground during the walk-through. The staff indicated that the children ranged in age from two to eight (2-8) years old. The maximum number of children that can be in a group with a two-year-old present with two (2) staff is twenty (20) children. The facility was over group size by one (1) child.
