- (1) A person who is a child care staff member prior to January 1, 2018, shall submit to and complete background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation no later than September 30, 2018.
- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and a review of documentation, a staff, hired on 08/14/19, did not submit to a background check. The staff member was observed alone and supervising six (6) children at the center's front door as they waited on a school bus to arrive.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, thirteen (13) children, ages one and two-years-old were present on the playground, supervised by two (2) staff. Therefore, group size was not maintained. Eight (8) children, aged infants through one-year-old, were supervised by one (1) staff for an hour in the infants' room.

- (7) If a director, employee, volunteer, or any person with supervisory or disciplinary control over, or having unsupervised contact with a child in care is named as the alleged perpetrator in a child abuse or neglect report accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330, the individual shall be removed from direct contact with a child in care:
- (a) For the duration of the assessment or investigation; and
- (b) Pending completion of the administrative appeal process for a cabinet substantiation of child abuse or neglect in accordance with 922 KAR 1:320 or 922 KAR 1:480.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a staff, hired on 08/31/92, and a staff, hired on 10/11/99, were named as alleged perpetrators in a child abuse or neglect report accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330, and were not removed from direct contact with a child in care. Instead, the staff members resumed regular duties in the classroom.

General: Based on observation and a review of documentation, a staff hired on 08/14/19, did not submit to a background check and supervised six (6) children, alone, at the center's front door from 12:15 pm to 12:23 pm, as they waited for a school bus to arrive at the center.
