General: Based on Observation, the hot water faucet did not turn on at a sink in the boys' restroom, adjacent to the gym. This sink was located left of the soap dispenser. Also, a cold water faucet would not turn off in the girls' restroom, adjacent to the gym. This sink was the first sink as a person entered into the girls' restroom.
