Findings

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. On 7/31/19 a three (3) year-old child was observed on video footage to be sleeping on the floor of the three (3) year-old room. A few children went over to the child and tried to wake him up. The child was unresponsive. The child was picked up by his teacher and moved to a cot in another area of the classroom. When the child was picked up, he appeared unresponsive. The child had no head or neck control and his arms and body appeared limp. The staff member then proceeded to clean up the art area, cut construction paper, and fill out paperwork. The teacher did not check on the child for approximately seven (7) minutes. The child's enrollment paperwork indicated that the child was prone to febrile seizures. The staff indicated in interview that the child had fallen asleep three (3) times during the day on 7/31/19. The staff stated that once the child fell asleep at the table during lunchtime. The child's mother was notified of his condition around 4:40 PM. The child's mother came to get the child. When the parents arrived, they called 911 because the child had a fever and appeared to be having a seizure.

Based on a review of documentation, the parent completed enrollment paperwork for her child on 9/18/18 and the enrollment paperwork indicated that her son has febrile seizures. The child's teacher, in the three (3) year-old room, indicated that she was not aware that the child had seizures, and the staff in charge was unaware that the child had seizures until the child's mother was called on 7/31/19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following items were observed during a tour of the facility:

- 1. A ceiling tile was missing in the hallway outside of the Toddler Room.
- 2. Three (3) stained ceiling tiles were located in the hallway outside of the Toddler Room.
