General: Based on observation during a tour of Classroom A-1, the surveyor found that a DVD/CD player had been stacked on top of a small television set. The television set had been placed on top of a VCR player located on a small table in the classroom. The items were easily moved, not properly secured and presented a safety risk to the children.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff's (DOH: 08/01/16) file contained a Child Abuse and Neglect background check that had been signed on 08/09/16 and returned as completed on 08/23/16. The Child Abuse and Neglect background check had not been submitted prior to or within five (5) days of the date of hire.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 08/01/16) file contained a criminal records background check dated 09/19/16. The background check was not completed prior to or on the date of hire.
- 3. A staff's (DOH: 08/01/16) file contained a criminal records background check dated 08/23/16. The background check was not completed prior to or on the date of hire.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a staff's (DOH: 08/01/15) file did not contain a High School Diploma, GED or Commonwealth Child Care Credential.

340 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

(14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found that a that a staff (DOH: 08/01/15) had obtained only seven (7) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education annual training during the review period.

- (7) Except in accordance with subsection (8) of this section, the following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
 - (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
 - (b) Knives and sharp objects;
 - (c) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids;
- (d) Plastic bags;
- (e) Litter and rubbish;
- (f) Bar soap; and
- (g) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

General: Based on observation during a tour of Classroom A-1, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. Two (2) rolls of empty black plastic garbage bags were stored on a small shelf located above a cubby in the classroom. The shelf was approximately three and a half to four feet (3 1/2 - 4) feet high. The plastic bags were within reach of the children.
- 2. Three (3) staplers and a box of staples had been stored on a small shelf located above a cubby in the classroom. The items were accessible to the children.
- 3. A bottle of Image Liquid Hand Soap had been stored in an unlocked cabinet located under the sink in the classroom. The label instructed that the soap should be kept out of the reach of children. **Hygienic Practices**

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the Emergency Preparedness Plan that was presented for review was dated 08/05/14. The surveyor could not verify that the plan had been updated or reviewed within the past year.
