Findings: General: Based on observation, a handwashing sink was not immediately adjacent to the diaper changing station in room 16. The handwashing sink was located in the restroom across the hall from room 16.

General: Based on observation, nine (9) children did not wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water after they returned from outdoor play in room 101. A child did not wash her hands with liquid soap and warm running water after her was diapered in room 16.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a caregiver wore gloves but did not wash her hands with liquid soap and warm running water before and after she changed a child's diaper in room 16. A caregiver did not wash her hands with liquid soap and warm running water after she wiped a child's nose in room 16.

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the center failed to assure each adult, including parents and guardians, at drop-off and pick-up, wore a face mask while inside a child care center, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:405E Section 8(1). Surveyor observed seven (7) caregivers each wear a face mask that hang down below their nose, which left their nose exposed.
