There was an uncovered electrical outlet in the Three's room. 2.) Coats were touching as they were hanged on the hooks close together in the hallway by the School-Age room. This method of storage promotes the spread of germs and bacteria In Compliance **Director Requirements Employee Records Not In Compliance** 415 - CPR/First Aid Required Training Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:120. Section 7. First Aid and Medicine. (8) Each center shall ensure that every staff member has received training on first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, four staff members (hire dates: 6/15/2018, 2/11/2019, 7/29/2021, and 1/31/2022) did not have evidence of completing the required CPR/First Aid training on file at the facility. A review of ECE-TRIS records supports the information found during the survey.



Inspection Report 435 - Training Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements. (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
