Findings:

General: Based on a review of documentation and interview, a caregiver, hire date 01/14/08, had TB documentation on file that was dated 09/09/14.

Outdoor Play Area

Not In Compliance

695 - Protective Surface Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(21) A protective surface shall:

- (a) Be provided for outdoor play equipment used to:
- 1. Climb;
- 2. Swing; and
- 3. Slide; and
- (b) Have a fall zone equal to the height of the equipment.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, mulch was scooted away by children's feet which exposed the dirt/hard ground underneath two (2) seats of a Fisher Price swing set at the rear of the pre-school playground. Mulch was also scooted away by children's feet which exposed the dirt/hard ground underneath two (2) seats of a blue metal swing set/climber/slide combo, at the front of the pre-school playground. A child, enrollment date 08/17/15, fell from a swing on the rear playground, landed on the hard ground underneath a swing and fractured his left arm. In addition, artificial turf grass was used as protective ground cover underneath four (4) swings and a Little Tykes climber on the infant/toddler playground.

700 - Fences Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (23) Fences shall be:
 - (a) Constructed of safe material;
 - (b) Stable; and
 - (c) In good condition.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a six (6) foot long vertical slat of wood was missing from the top section of the fence between the infant/toddler playground and the preschool playground. Two (2) exposed nails were observed on the pre-school side of the fence and two (2) exposed nails were on the infant/toddler side of the fence. Also, an eighteen (18) foot section of wooden fence, located between the toy storage building and back of the pre-school playground, was leaning inwards towards the playground and was unstable.

Equipment Not In Compliance

760 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
 - (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a three foot by three foot section of trellis, used to enclose the sides of a four (4) foot tall tree house, was not secured on one side. The unsecured section of trellis had sharp corners and edges.
