- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, a caregiver, hire date of 11/20/18, had not obtained a criminal records check. Based on observation, the aforementioned staff member worked alone with seven (7) children in the four and five-year-olds' classroom. Interview with director determined this caregiver worked daily from 8:30 am - 5:30 pm, five (5) days a week, since 11/20/18.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, three (3) children had their picture taken by a caregiver who used her personal cellphone in the four-year-old and five-year-olds' classroom. This caregiver shared this information with an parent whose child was one of the children in the picture. A review of the three (3) children's files indicated permission for "photographic purposes only" was signed by each child's parent; however, there was no permission for the photo to be shared with the public.
