Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, a staff hired on 03/05/2020, and a staff, hired on 03/16/2020, did not have education verification on file.

- (a) Posted in writing in a conspicuous location with each age group and followed;**
- (b) Of activities that are individualized and developmentally appropriate for each child served;**
- (c) That provides experience to promote the individual child's physical, emotional, social, and intellectual growth and well-being; and**
- (d) Unless the child-care center is a before- or after-school program that operates part day or less, that offers a variety of creative activities including:**
 - 1. Art or music;**
 - 2. Math or numbers;**
 - 3. Dramatic play;**
 - 4. Stories and books;**
 - 5. Science or nature;**
 - 6. Block building or stacking;**
 - 7. Tactile or sensory activity;**
 - 8. Multi-cultural exposure;**
 - 9. Indoor or outdoor play in which a child makes use of both small and large muscles;**
 - 10. A balance of active and quiet play, including group and individual activity;**
 - 11. An opportunity for a child to:**
 - a. Have some free choice of activities;**

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the posted program of activities was dated 06/29/2020 - 07/03/2020, and was not followed in the Preschool classroom.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a green adult-size jacket was placed on the back of the adult chair and was accessible to children in the older two-year olds' classroom.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, dirt was underneath (2) swings in the younger children's play area.

- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and**

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the top freezer doors were broken and the bottom doors were smashed inward on two (2) child size plastic refrigerators on the older children's playground. In addition, the plastic sink top and the cupboard door was missing on the child size plastic sink and cupboard play set on the older children's playground.

820 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

(2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:

- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, rust was visible on the chains of five (5) swings in the preschool play area. In addition, rust was visible the handle bars of a slide, a climbing wagon apparatus and a blue climbing apparatus on the older children's playground. Steps on a Step2 play climber and swing set were broken on the older children's playground.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:400E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on review of 922 KAR 2:400E, Section 8, Training Requirements. (1) All child care staff, directors, owners, and operators shall complete a new, mandatory training on cleaning, sanitizing, health procedures, and mandatory reporting prior to the date of reopening. The director failed to provide for the health of children as evidenced by two (2) staff members hired 03/05/2020 and 03/16/2020 failed to complete the mandated training prior to the center reopening.
