During interview, staff stated that they were not aware of the socks being on the sink and would have then removed.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation presented and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found:

- 1. Staff (DOH: 12/15/18) obtained the six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation on 07/28/19; however, the training was not obtained during the staff's first three (3) months of employment.
- 2. There was no documentation of staff (DOH: 09/28/18) completing one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training within the first year of employment.

During interview, staff stated that they were not aware of training not being up to date.

During interview, staff stated that they were not aware the ratio information had been modified.
