- (a) Posted in writing in a conspicuous location with each age group and followed;
- (b) Of activities that are individualized and developmentally appropriate for each child served;
- (c) That provides experience to promote the individual child's physical, emotional, social, and intellectual growth and well-being; and
- (d) Unless the child-care center is a before- or after-school program that operates part day or less, that offers a variety of creative activities including:

1. Art or music;
2. Math or numbers;
3. Dramatic play;
4. Stories and books;
5. Science or nature;
6. Block building or stacking;
7. Tactile or sensory activity;
8. Multi-cultural exposure;
9. Indoor or outdoor play in which a child makes use of both small and large muscles;
10. A balance of active and quiet play, including group and individual activity;
11. An opportunity for a child to:
 - a. Have some free choice of activities;
 - b. If desired, play apart from the group at times;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found in the School Age 2 Classroom the Lesson Plan was dated for 2/8-2/12. Staff reported that the center does not use the room that often but will make sure to have the Lesson Plan updated.

Findings: General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following: 1. In the walk way in front of the Three and Four Year Old Classroom the ceiling tile was missing. Staff reported that it fell while they were out due to a leak from the roof. Staff stated that the owner of the building has been notified about the ceiling tile being gone. 2. In the Three and Four Year Old Classroom there was a missing ceiling tile in the left corner when standing with your back to the door. Staff stated that the ceiling tile will be fixed. 3. In the Four Year Old Classroom there was a ceiling tile in the right corner on the right side of the door that was stained. Staff reported that they would have it repaired. 4. In the Four Year Old Classroom there was a ceiling tile in the right corner on the right side of the door that appeared to be off the track that holds it up. Staff stated she was not aware of the ceiling tile hanging down off the track.
