(1) An infant shall sleep or nap on the infant's back unless the infant's health professional signs a waiver that states the infant requires an alternate sleeping position.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a boppy nursing pillow was placed under a crib mattress in the infants' room. Interview determined the center did not have a waiver from the infant's health professional to change the infant's sleeping position.
