General: Based on observation, a light fixture, located in the dining room, was not shielded and did not have shatter-proof bulbs.

645 - Sink Not In Compliance

- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;

General: Based on observation, the hot water temperature registered one hundred thirty (130) degrees Fahrenheit at a sink in the restroom near the two and three-year-old's room, at a sink located in a restroom near the dining room, and at a sink located in the nursery.

General: Based on observation, the center failed to ensure machine washable toys were not used, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:415E Section 6 (3). Several stuffed animals, ten (10) stuffed dolls, two (2) large turquoise pillows, one (1) purple pillow, and one (1) yellow pillow were in the preschool room. Three (3) large pillows and several stuffed animals were in the nursery. Also, three (3) dolls and six (6) stuffed animals were in the two and three-year-old's room.
