- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that two (2) staff did not have evidence of an annual performance evaluation on file at the facility. The dates of hire for these staff are 09/01/2017 and 02/19/2018.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1) None of the staff completed the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training.
- 2) Four (4) staff did not have evidence of completing the required pediatric abusive head trauma training within the last five (5) years. The dates of hire for these staff were: 10/15/2012, 08/05/2013, 08/05/2013, and 09/01/2017.

A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed these findings.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) There were two holes in the wall in the two (2) year old classroom. One of the holes was located under the music center sign and the other was located in the dramatic play area next to the white mirror hanging on the wall.
- 2) There were brown water spots on the ceiling in the dramatic play area of the one (1) year old classroom.
- 3) There was a hole in the wall under where the CD player was located in the one (1) year old classroom.
- 4) In the closet with the sink in the one (1) year old classroom there were areas with mismatching paint, as well as an area that appeared to have a hole forming in the drywall. This area was cracking and crumbling.


