- (3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no staff on duty and present with children certified in first aide and CPR training. The center's staff received first aid and CPR training through the National CPR Foundation, which was not a cabinet approved source.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) caregivers hired on 8/30/08 and 8/15/99, last completed cabinet approved pediatric abusive head trauma training on 6/6/13. A caregiver hired on 8/15/92, last completed cabinet approved pediatric abusive head trauma training on 5/31/13. Each staff failed to complete the training within five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a child enrolled on 8/13/18, had an immunization certificate on file that was valid until 5/15/20.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (f) A written annual plan for child-care staff professional development;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, three (3) caregivers hired on 8/30/08, 8/15/99, and 8/15/92, each had a professional development plan on file that was dated 3/1/19. Also, a substitute hired on 8/1/18, had a professional development plan on file that was dated 4/16/19.

General: Based on review of documentation, the center's cat had a rabies vaccination valid until 5/4/2020.

Emergency Regulation

1250 - Emergency Regulation Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:400E. Emergency Regulation.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:400E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on review of 922KAR2:400E. Enhanced requirements for certified and licensed child care as a result of a declared state of emergency. Section 5. Cleaning and Sanitizing Requirements for Child Care Providers. (3) Machine washable toys shall not be used. Section 7. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Requirements. Each adult, including parents and guardians at drop-off and pick-up, shall wear a face mask while inside a child care center or family child care home. Surveyor observation revealed machine washable stuffed animals were present in classrooms #2 and #3. Also, surveyor observed three (3) caregivers, who cared for nine (9) children, did not wear a face masks. An interview determined the caregivers had medical reasons for not wearing the mask, but did not have medical statements on file.
